

COMMISSIONER PROCEEDINGS

March 30, 2023

The Wallace County Board of Commissioners met in special session with, Larry Townsend, Chairman, Michael Cowles, Commissioner, Becky Larson, Commissioner, and Brionna Colvin, County Clerk present.

Debbie Welsh and Jacalyn Mai were also present.

Chairman Townsend and Commissioner Larson joined the meeting via phone call.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Townsend for business at 11:30 a.m.

Chairman Townsend is a steering committee member of the Kansas Natural Resource Coalition (KNRC). Chairman Townsend explained what information the KNRC board has discussed at their meetings. Currently the KNRC is in a Pacific Legal Foundation Litigation (PLF) with The United States Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS). The USFWS is considering Lesser-Prairie Chickens to be a threatened species. Chairman Townsend reported on what the KNRC is planning to file a lawsuit.
